

# PISTOL RANGE RULES

## Phase 3, Part 2: Reopening

**Revised Oct. 5, 2020**

### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. **MEMBERS AND GUESTS.** One guest per member will be allowed. Direct family members who are under 21 and live in the same household are considered members. Please bring your membership card with you.
2. **FACE MASKS** or other suitable face coverings are required at all times.
3. **HAND SANITIZER STATIONS** are located at entrances to all ranges.
4. **RESTROOMS** with hand washing stations are located inside the skeet house and inside the entrance to the indoor archery range.
5. **FOOD/DRINK.** If you bring food or a drink to the club grounds, don't share it and take your trash home.
6. **LESSONS** may be conducted subject to proper spacing requirements.
7. **DO NOT SHARE EQUIPMENT** such as eye/ear protection, firearms, staplers, etc.

### RANGE REQUIREMENTS:

1. **RANGE FEES AND SIGN-IN ARE REINSTATED** for Phase 3, Part 2 of the range reopening.
2. **USE OF THE PISTOL RANGE BUILDING IS NOW ALLOWED.** Only 3 shooting ports (50% of the total) may be used per Phase 3, Part 2 of the Governor's reopening Executive Order. A maximum of 1 additional observer may be in the building due to its size.
3. **SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIREMENTS** are no closer than 6' from another person.
4. **TARGETS, STAPLERS OR TAPE** for use on target stands must be provided by each shooter.
5. **FIRED BRASS** must be picked up and placed in the appropriate bucket or container.
