Club Upgrades – Thanks to numerous and exceptional volunteers who have helped make tremendous upgrades to the pistol house and range, the rifle range, skeet house and banquet hall. We encourage all members to come see and take advantage of our significant improvements. Special thanks to Jim Balfanz who oversaw this work. Jim leveraged the roughly \$19K of donations to the capital improvement fund to far more than DOUBLE that amount. While there is still more to be done, the renovations have made such a fantastic impact on the club facilities that it cannot be overstated.

Dues and Fee Increases – As most of you know, the board voted to increase dues and fees to enable us to keep pace with these inflationary times. We have always felt that we wanted to keep our dues as low as possible, and we have lagged other area clubs in this regard. However, the reality of the current economic conditions requires us to make these increases if we are to maintain the high quality of the SSC. Our membership chairman Wayne Myers informed us at the last board meeting on 12/20 that we still have 135 members outstanding in their dues. As a result of that, we have extended the expiration of 2022 memberships until January 31st, 2023. At that time members who have not paid will be dropped from the roster or required to pay the \$50 reinstatement fee along with the 2023 dues. We need you, and hopefully each of you agree that the club and everything it does will continue to have your support.

Special Appreciation – Goes out to board member Bill Cahill who has taken it upon himself to separate weekly the shell casings at both the rifle and pistol ranges. The recycled casings bring the club more in value when they are separated rather than mixed together (brass/steel/aluminum). All members are requested to assist by putting their spent casings in the **appropriate** and **clearly labeled** buckets.

Heartfelt Thanks – Goes out to one of our newest board members, Jeremy Bigelow and 53 Plumbing, for the donation of a hot water system for the skeet house, that has been severely lacking since the house was built. It should be noted that this \$3K donation is not included in the previous mention of capital improvement gifting.
